

Copyright Licences

Under the terms of our agreements with the Copyright Licensing Agency ("the CLA") and the Newspaper Licensing Agency ("the NLA") we are required to draw your attention to the following:

1. The supply of cuttings by a press cuttings agency to a client does not carry with it permission to make further photocopies, electronic copies, or to fax that cutting.
2. Clients who do photocopy, electronically scan/disseminate or fax cuttings from publications that are listed as forming part of the respective repertoires of the CLA and NLA will normally require a licence from the CLA or the NLA. These repertoires are available at the CLA and NLA websites.
3. Cuttings supplied electronically by Durrants under the CLA Licence include a right for the recipient to open, view and print out a single paper copy (but no right to make further paper copies) following which the electronic document must be destroyed. If you take out your own CLA Licence, this will permit further use such as limited storage, on-copying and printing within your company.
4. Clients who receive cuttings supplied electronically by Durrants under the NLA Licence will require a digital licence unless the service is restricted to one user only.
