

Press cuttings and copyright compliance

The copyright licence that press cutting agencies hold with the Copyright Licensing Agency Limited (CLA) has recently changed. From April 1st, clients of all press cuttings agencies receiving multiple access to clippings from magazines, journals or books, either through a web-based portal or receipt by other methods of electronic delivery, must hold a licence from the Copyright Licensing Agency, or other statutory authority to ensure legal copying.

A licence is required by your organisation if electronic clippings are accessed more than once, or by more than one individual, or if additional copies are made from clippings received either electronically or in hard-copy.

CLA licences enable not only the multiple access, distribution and storage internally of press clippings, but also ensure that your employees within your organisation are legally permitted to:

- photocopy an article from a book or magazine
- copy or download an article from an original digital publication
- photocopy or scan a magazine article or clipping received from a press agency

Most businesses and public authorities recognise that copyright compliance is part of the ethics of corporate governance and already subscribe to the CLA licence.
