

A guide to CLA licensing

If you subscribe to a press cuttings service from a media monitoring agency, it's likely that you will require a CLA licence.

All clients of press cuttings agencies (PCAs) that engage in multiple access to electronic clippings from magazines, journals or books, either through a web-based portal or receipt by other methods of electronic delivery, must hold a valid licence from CLA or other appropriate authority to ensure legal copying.

UK PCAs licensed by the CLA are required to provide the names of organisations receiving press cuttings from journals and magazines either in hard copy or electronically (by e-mail or by web-enabled delivery). Unless you have secured direct permissions from the copyright owners, your organisation will require a licence if electronic clippings are accessed more than once, or by more than one employee, or if additional copies are made from clippings received either electronically or in hard-copy.

It's also important to be aware that a CLA licence or other authorisation is required if any copying of books, magazines and journals occurs within your organisation.



A CLA licence enables your organisation to:

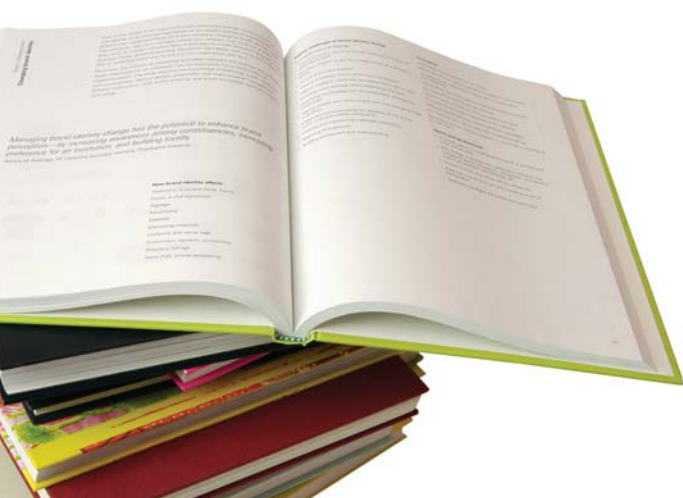
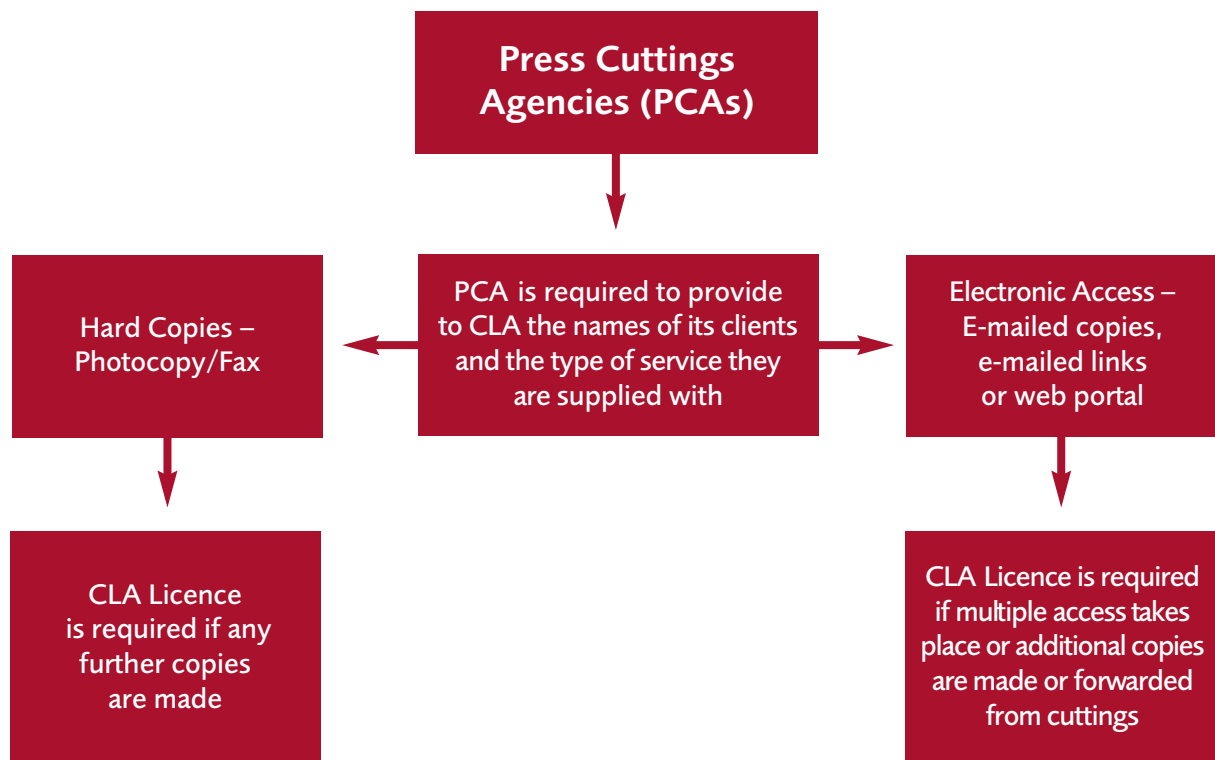
- Copy and share articles from millions of UK and international news, trade or consumer publications
- Email press cuttings and articles received from Media Monitoring Agencies and other Document Supply Agencies
- Copy or re-use extracts from a large range of digital publications such as online trade journals or electronic reports and newsletters
- Store copied or purchased articles on a secure intranet for up to 30 days.

Public Relations & Marketing Companies

If you are a PR firm or Marketing consultancy receiving material from a media monitoring agency that may be copied internally or forwarded to your clients, a CLA Licence is also required.



A CLA licence is the most convenient way to ensure ongoing compliance with the law when staff receive, use or copy content, such as business information, market news, industry comments, research articles and PR coverage from magazines, trade press and other publications.
